Press Release: Vehicle Heavily Damages Restaurant - 02/26/2024

For Immediate Release

Today at 3:56PM, the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District responded to Jimmy John's, 361 S. Eastwood Drive in Woodstock, for a vehicle that reportedly struck the building.

Firefighters arrived within minutes and observed the aftermath of a vehicle that drove through the storefront of the restaurant. Crews quickly made contact with the driver who had exited the building prior to their arrival. The vehicle caused significant damage to the storefront and interior of the restaurant, but no structural damage was evident. The elderly female driver was evaluated by paramedics but declined any further medical attention. The restaurant was open at the time and fortunately no injuries were reported in the incident.

Representatives from both the McHenry County Department of Health and City of Woodstock Building & Zoning were requested to the scene.

The Woodstock Police Department is investigating the crash and any additional questions pertaining to the investigation (cause, fault, seat-belt use, speeds, etc.) should be referred to them.
