#### **WOODSTOCK FIRE/RESCUE DISTRICT MISSION:**

The mission of the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District is to protect life and property through efficient and professional service to our community.

#### **DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW:**

The Woodstock Fire/Rescue District operates as an Illinois special district unit of local government. The District provides fire prevention, fire suppression, rescue, special unit response, and emergency medical services. A five-member Board of Trustees elected at large from the community serves as the governing corporate authority.

The Woodstock Fire/Rescue District encompasses an 81 square-mile jurisdiction located in central McHenry county. It operates out of three stations, serving a residential population of approximately 40,000 and protects a mix of residential, light industrial and commercial development. The District employs 59 commissioned and non-commissioned firefighting personnel, 2 civilian staff members, and 1 full time mechanic, and responded to approximately 5,300 emergency incidents in 2022.

The selection process includes application, written exam, and oral interview. Background investigation, psychological exam, and medical exam are completed upon conditional offer of employment.

1. To complete an application and schedule your written exam, go to <a href="www.nationaltestingnetwork.com">www.nationaltestingnetwork.com</a>, select Firefighter Jobs and sign up for the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District exam. Only ONLINE applications will be accepted.

- Opportunity to take online practice tests;
- Schedule your own convenient test time. Tests are offered multiple times a week, including Saturdays;
- Take high quality job simulation tests in a standardized, fair testing environment;

Upon completion of the written exam, all candidate scores will be automatically forwarded to the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District hiring officials. Candidates who attain a passing score will be placed in the department's pool of eligible candidates to continue to participate in other stages of the selection process.
