

ORDINANCE # 163

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF PROPERTY BETWEEN THE CITY OF WOODSTOCK AND WOODSTOCK FIRE/RESCUE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District Board of Trustees (“transferee municipality”) desires to receive a transfer of real estate from the City of Woodstock (“transferor municipality”), and

WHEREAS, a transfer of property between governmental entities is governed by 50 ILCS 605, et. seq., entitled the “Local Government Property Transfer Act,” which authorizes a municipality to transfer real estate or any interest therein, under the provisions of this Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE WOODSTOCK FIRE/RESCUE DISTRICT, THAT:

The transferee municipality does declare that it is necessary or convenient for it to use, occupy or improve the property currently held by the transferor municipality in the making of any public improvement or for any public purpose.

DEFINITIONS

The term “held” or any form thereof, when used in reference to the interest of a municipality in real estate shall be taken and constructed to refer to and include all of the right, title and interest of such municipality of whatever kind or nature, in and to such real estate.

MISCELLANEOUS

Section One: Any ordinances or parts of ordinances that are in conflict or inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they conflict.

Section Two: The invalidation of any section, part, provision, term or phrase of the Ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this Ordinance.

Section Three: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication. The Secretary is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance as required by law.
