

ORDINANCE NO. 170

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CHARGES
FOR THE PROVISION OF EXTRICATION SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District is a unit of local government duly organized under provisions of, 70 ILCS 705/1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (“Board”) of the Fire Protection District has full power to pass all necessary resolutions and to conduct the business of the board (70 ILCS 705/6); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District has determined that it would be in the best interest of the District that a charge be established for the provision of vehicle extrication services.

WHEREAS, fire protection districts in the State of Illinois have been expressly authorized under 70 ILCS 705/26 to charge service fees for technical rescue; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that vehicle extrication qualifies as “technical rescue”; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that \$500.00 is a reasonable charge for said technical rescue in light of the amount of manpower necessary and the equipment required to perform such services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF
TRUSTEES OF THE WOODSTOCK FIRE/RESCUE DISTRICT THAT:**

1. That the above findings are incorporated as though fully set forth herein.
2. The charge for vehicle extrication services shall be the sum of \$500.00 for each vehicle wherein extrication is necessary. Said charge to be levied against the driver of any such vehicle, or, if a minor, to the owner of such vehicle.


3. The extrication service charge shall be effective October 22, 2009, and shall remain in effect until further modified by the Board of Trustees for the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District.
