ORDINANCE NO. 182

TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the WOODSTOCK FIRE/RESCUE DISTRICT in the County of McHenry, State of Illinois, did on the 23rd day of June, 2011, pass the Combined Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the said District for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of May, 2011, and ending on the 30th day of April, 2012, and which Combined Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance was published on the 29th day of June, 2011: and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the WOODSTOCK FIRE/RESCUE DISTRICT was not required to publish a Notice pursuant to the Truth in Taxation Act or to hold a hearing on the Tax and Levy Increase, in accordance with 35 ILCS 20018-55 et seq.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the WOODSTOCK FIRE/RESCUE DISTRICT in the County of McHenry and State of Illinois, there is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the corporate limits of the WOODSTOCK FIRE/RESCUE DISTRICT, for the year of 2011, the total sum of FIVE MILLION THREE HUNDRED FOURTEEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED TWENTY-THREE AND 00/100 (\$5,314,323.00) DOLLARS and that the objects and purposes for which said Levy is made are as follows, to-wit;
